Eurobent Sp. z o.o. informs that the release by Concrete Canvas Ltd. of 15th April 2020 entitled "CONCRETE CANVAS PATENT SUCCESS - EUROBENT'S SECOND (FINAL) APPEAL DISMISSED" contains inaccuracies and misleading statements as to developments in the litigation between Concrete Canvas Ltd. and Eurobent Sp. z o.o.

Therefore, Eurobent Sp. z o.o. explains as follows:

In April 2018, a Polish court issued an order to secure claims.

This is not a preliminary injunction, as Concrete Canvas Ltd. purports. It is merely an order that secures Concrete Canvas Ltd. interests for the duration of proceedings in the main case.

As long as the main case remains pending, the order to secure claims may be modified at any time. It may also be revoked if new evidence or facts emerge in the main case.

It is not true that the proceedings for securing of claims have definitively ended.

The judgment in the main case has yet to be pronounced. The case is still pending before the Court.

We would like to note that Eurobent Sp. z o.o. has already successfully defended its position in litigation against Concrete Canvas Ltd. in the first instance court in Germany. This court categorically stated that there was no infringement of the patent held by Concrete Canvas Ltd.
