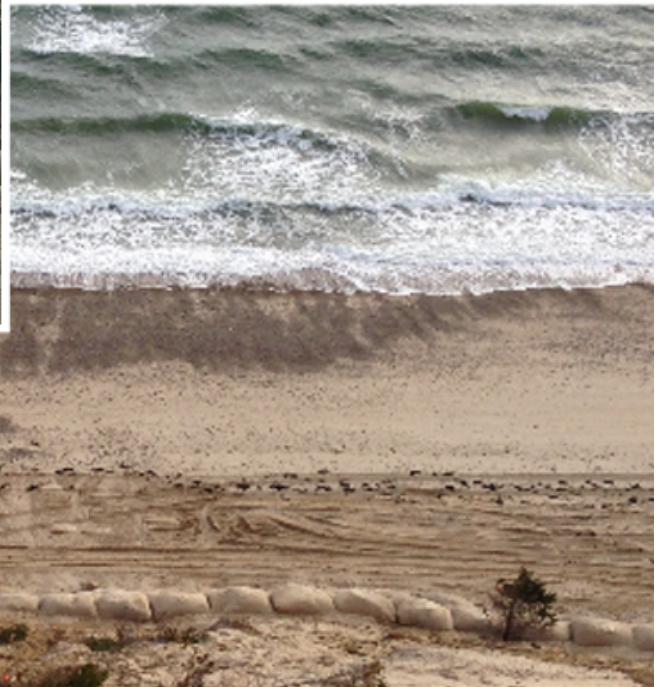

Case Study - White Cliffs Country Club - Plymouth MA, USA

Chronic erosion combined with annual episodes of erosion from northeaster storms battered the coast of the White Cliffs Country Club, resulting in significant sloughing of thousands of cubic yards of sand and coastal bank and loss of portions of signature coastal golf 18th hole aesthetics on the Gary Player Course. Little Environments PLLC consulted with the local permitting entity to develop an extended longevity coastal erosion management solution. ELCOROCK geosynthetic containers were imported from Australia and applied in a consolidated geosynthetic container revetment. Consulting included development of an innovative strategy that took advantage of gravity, minimizing the machinery required to fill and place the containers. Minimal heavy civil engineering machinery meant significantly reduced impacts to the environments and resultantly streamlined permitting.
