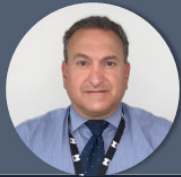

The **National Construction Code** is a performance code which permits compliance through two pathways, the **Deemed-to-Satisfy (DtS)** and/or **Performance Solution** approach. The **DtS** approach is a prescriptive methodology primarily based on legacy building regulations. As a result, not all **DtS** compliant buildings completely achieve the **Performance Requirements** of the **NCC**, even though they are compliant!

This becomes problematic when the public, or even the regulator fails to understand the resultant consequences. Quoting the **Victorian Building Authority** addressing a draft Fire Engineering Brief for a specific building: ***"The VBA disagreed with the statement that the DtS provisions may not provide an adequate level of safety"***.
