Special Issue on 'Durability of Geosynthetics'

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Geosynthetics are building materials that occupy a prominent place in many civil and environmental engineering works. The long-term behaviour of these materials, which has often to be predicted, is a key issue for their application. The guarantee of durability is not an option but a demand. "How long will they last?" is the question that has to be answered properly.

The special issue on "Durability of Geosynthetics" aims to gather papers with relevant advances in the knowledge about the long-term behaviour of geosynthetics. The degradation agents/mechanisms covered in the special issue include but are not limited to liquids, oxidation, weathering, biological agents, creep, abrasion, and installation damage. Developments in laboratory and field testing of geosynthetics, and the effect of stabilisers on the long-term behaviour of geosynthetics are welcomed. Case studies on the durability of geosynthetics are also desired.
